Rehearsal:

- **Level I, II, and Advanced** students will need to be at the Auditorium at 1:00pm to rehearse. This will be a closed rehearsal. Students will need to be picked up at 2:00pm.
- **Beginning Level** students will need to be at the Auditorium at 2:00pm to rehearse. This will be a closed rehearsal. These students will stay at the Auditorium after their rehearsal. Beginning Level Students will need to show up in costume for rehearsal.

Performance:

All Students will need to return to the Auditorium at 3:15pm. Please have your child come in their costume and make-up. **The performance will begin at 3:30pm.**

Costume Information:

- **Ballet:** Ballet Pink Tights
- **Advanced Ballet/Pointe:** Light Tan Tights
- **Jazz, Tap, Lyrical, Contemporary:** Light Tan Tights

Students who have a costume change:

- Please have your student wear a nude spaghetti strapped leotard so that changing costumes goes quickly and easily. If students have a change in tight color, they will wear the second pair under the leotard and the first pair on top. I will have the schedule out for the order of dances soon.

Makeup:

- All students will need to wear eye shadow, mascara (if possible), blush, and lipstick. It is important that the students have a little bit of makeup on so that their faces do not white out on the stage. Please do not send your student with makeup, have all their makeup on before they arrive to the performance.

Hair:

- Hair needs to be pulled back in a bun for all classes. Short hair may be pulled back as much as possible. Please feel free to put a barrette, or something fun in if you would like.

Jewelry:

- Please do not wear necklaces or bracelets, stud earrings are ok.

Food and Drink:

- Food and drink are not allowed in the Auditorium. Please do not send anything with your child except a water bottle.
